Requirements to be a London 2012 Student Ambassador

Essential:

- Able to inspire fellow students and staff
- Excellent communication skills, both written and oral
- Ability to show initiative and take responsibility for tasks
- Good organisational and time management skills
- Ability to lead and manage other students
- Passion for, and knowledge of, the Olympic and Paralympic Games

Desirable:

- Experience of running student led programmes
- Previous engagement in Games inspired initiatives e.g. Young Ambassadors, Trailblazers
- Commitment and passion for volunteering

What can you do?

- You can run any campaign you wish as long as it is linked to London 2012. This can range from healthy lifestyle through to photo collages.
